SUBJ: AVIATION BATTLEDRESS UNIFORM (A8DU) WOODLAND CAMOUFLAGE

1. THE DEFENSE PERSONNEL SUPPORT CENTER (S9T) WILL BE ACCEPTING FUNDED REQUISITIONS FOR AIRCREW BATTLEDRESS UNIFORMS (ABDU) WOODLAND CAMOUFLAGE ON 9 JUNE 1997.

2. THE UNIFORM CONSISTS OF A COAT AND TROUSERS. THE COAT IS OF "BUSH TYPE" DESIGN WITH TWO CHEST AND TWO LOWER PATCH POCKETS WITH FLAPS, LEFT SLEEVE UTILITY POCKET WITH FLAP, HOOK AND LOOP FASTENER TAPE ON ALL POCKET FLAPS AND ON ADJUSTMENT TABS FOR THE WAIST, COLLAR AND WRIST, AND A SLIDE FASTENER FRONT CLOSURE. THE TROUSERS CONTAIN TWO SIDE HANGING POCKETS, TWO HIP POCKETS, TWO CARGO POCKETS AND TWO LOWER LEG POCKETS. ALL POCKETS EXCEPT FOR THE SIDE HANGING POCKETS HAVE A FLAP CLOSURE. HOOK AND LOOP FASTENER TAPE IS USED FOR ALL POCKET CLOSURES. THE TROUSERS HAVE A SLIDE FASTENER FLY CLOSURE AND LEG HEM DRAWTAPES.

3. THE UNIFORM WILL BE FUNCTIONAL DURING NORMAL OPERATION AND PROVIDE PROTECTION AGAINST FLASH FIRES. IT IS COLOR COMPATIBLE WITH GROUND SOLDIER UNIFORMS AND PROVIDES CREWMEN WITH THE FLEXIBILITY NEEDED FOR FIELD OPERATIONS WHEN ARMING AND REFUELING TANKS AND HELICOPTERS, AND DURING

ESCAPE AND EVASION SITUATIONS.

4. BASIS OF ISSUE FOR SUBJECT UNIFORM IS THREE (3) PER INDIVIDUAL ON FLYING STATUS WHOSE PRIMARY DUTY IS FLYING EXCLUDING FIXED WING AIRCRAFT CREWMEMBERS (C-12 & U-21 CREWMEMBERS). ONE (1) PER INDIVIDUAL ON FLYING STATUS WHOSE PRIMARY DUTY IS NOT FLYING. TWO (2) PER INDIVIDUALS, MOS 11A, 11C, 11M, 13B, 13C, 13E, 13F, 13M, 13P, AND 13 SERIES OFFICERS ASSIGNED AS CREWMEN IN COMBAT VEHICLES.

5. AS OF 9 JUNE, THE ONLY AUTHORIZED USER OF THE CURRENT COVERALLS, FLYERS (LIN F32055) WILL BE C-12 AND U-21 FIXED WING CREWMEMBERS.
