SUBJECT: AR 670-1, 3 FEB 05, WEAR AND APPEARANCE OF ARMY UNIFORMS AND INSIGNIA

1. THIS MESSAGE SERVES AS IMPLEMENTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR CHANGES TO THE WEAR POLICY OUTLINED IN AR 670-1 REFERENCE CIVIL AFFAIRS AND PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS BRANCH INSIGNIAS.

2. THE FOLLOWING CHANGES ARE MADE TO AR 670-1:

A. PARAGRAPH 28-9G IS CHANGED TO READ: CIVIL AFFAIRS (CA) OFFICERS WEAR BRANCH INSIGNIA AS FOLLOWS:

B. PARAGRAPH 28-9G(2) IS CHANGED TO READ: WHEN ASSIGNED TO A CA TROOP PROGRAM UNIT THAT HAS MOBILIZED.

C. PARAGRAPH 28-10B(11) IS CHANGED TO READ: CIVIL AFFAIRS. THE OFFICER BRANCH INSIGNIA IS GOLD-COLORED GLOBE, 5/8 INCH IN DIAMETER, UPON WHICH IS SUPERIMPOSED A TORCH OF LIBERTY, 1 INCH IN HEIGHT, SURMOUNTED BY A SCROLL AND SWORD CROSSED IN SALTIRE, ENLISTED PERSONNEL HAVE THE SAME DESIGN ON A 1-INCH DISK IN GOLD-COLORED METAL (SEE FIG 28-79).

D. PARAGRAPH 28-10B(26) IS CHANGED TO READ: PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS. THE OFFICER BRANCH INSIGNIA IS A GOLD-COLORED TROJAN HORSE WITH LIGHTNING BOLTS AND TWO SWORDS, 1 INCH IN HEIGHT. ENLISTED PERSONNEL HAVE THE SAME DESIGN ON A 1-INCH DISK (SEE FIG 28-94 A AND B).

E. PARAGRAPH 28-19K IS CHANGED TO READ: CIVIL AFFAIRS: PURPLE AND WHITE (CABLE NUMBERS 65009 AND 65005)

POLICY CONTAINED IN THIS MESSAGE IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.

2. BECAUSE OF LIMITED INVENTORY OF THE TAN ICWB, SOLDIERS IN THE
FOLLOWING AREAS HAVE BEEN GRANTED A TEMPORARY EXCEPTION TO
POLICY TO WEAR THE BLACK ICWB WITH THE ACU FROM NOV 06 THRU APR 07
IN CLIMATE ZONES 3 THRU 7, IAW CTA 50-900, APPENDIX B-3, WHICH COVERS
THE FOLLOWING AREAS:
 - A. COLD REGIONS OF THE UNITED STATES
 - B. KOREA
 - C. EUROPE
 - D. ALASKA

SUBJECT: WEAR POLICY FOR FLAGS WORN ON THE ARMY COMBAT
UNIFORM (ACU), THE ACU PATROL CAP, AND THE BERET

1. AR 670-1, 3 FEB 05, WEAR AND APPEARANCE OF ARMY UNIFORMS AND INSIGNIA AND ACU ENSEMBLE ALARACT MESSAGE 078/2005, DATED 20 APR 05.
2. THE PURPOSE OF THIS MESSAGE IS TO REEMPHASIZE THE WEAR POLICY FOR THE FLAGS WORN ON THE ACU, THE ACU PATROL CAP, AND THE BERET. COMMANDERS AND LEADERS AT ALL LEVELS WILL ENSURE SOLDIERS ARE COMPLYING WITH THE WEAR POLICY OUTLINED IN AR 670-1, PARAGRAPH 3-5 , PARAGRAPH 28-18, AND THE ACU ENSEMBLE ALARACT MESSAGE 078/2005.
3. STATE AND TERRITORY FLAGS ARE NOT AUTHORIZED TO BE WORN ON THE ACU OR ANY OTHER UTILITY UNIFORM.
4. THE U.S. FLAG INSIGNIA (FULL COLOR OR SUBDUED) IS WORN ON THE RIGHT SHOULDER POCKET FLAP OF THE ACU COAT. THE FLAG INSIGNIA IS PLACED DIRECTLY ON TOP OF THE HOOK AND LOOP-FACED PAD ALREADY PROVIDED WITH THE ACU COAT SHOULDER POCKET FLAP. THE SUBDUED U.S. FLAG INSIGNIA IS WORN AS DIRECTED BY THE COMMANDER UNDER TACTICAL OR FIELD CONDITIONS ONLY. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL LEADERS AUTHORIZED WEAR OF ANY OTHER FLAG INSIGNIAS ON THE ACU OR ANY OTHER UTILITY UNIFORMS APPROVED FOR WEAR BY THE U.S. ARMY.
5. THE ACU PATROL CAP IS WORN WITH THE ACU IN FIELD ENVIRONMENTS WHEN THE KEVLAR HELMET IS NOT WORN, ON WORK DETAILS, OR IN OTHER ENVIRONMENTS WHERE THE WEAR OF THE BERET IS IMPRACTICAL AS DETERMINED BY THE COMMANDER. PERSONNEL WILL WEAR THE ACU PATROL CAP STRAIGHT ON THE HEAD SO THAT THE CAP BAND CREATES A STRAIGHT LINE AROUND THE HEAD, PARALLEL TO THE GROUND. THE PATROL CAP WILL FIT SNUGLY

AND COMFORTABLY AROUND THE LARGEST PART OF THE HEAD WITHOUT DISTORTION OR EXCESSIVE GAPS. THE CAP IS WORN SO THAT NO HAIR IS VISIBLE ON THE FOREHEAD BENEATH THE CAP. SEWN OR PIN ON RANK IS WORN ON THE ACU PATROL CAP. THE LAST NAME TAPE WILL BE WORN CENTERED ON THE HOOK AND LOOP PADS ON THE BACK OF THE ACU PATROL CAP ONLY.

6. THE BLACK BERET BECAME THE STANDARD HEADGEAR FOR UTILITY UNIFORMS ON 14 JUNE 2001. THE BERET WILL BE WORN WITH UTILITY UNIFORMS IN GARRISON ENVIRONMENTS.

SUBJECT: 100 PERCENT COTTON FOLIAGE GREEN T-SHIRT

1. AR 670-1, 3 FEB 05, WEAR AND APPEARANCE OF ARMY UNIFORMS AND INSIGNIA.
2. THE PURPOSE OF THIS MESSAGE IS TO ANNOUNCE THE WEAR POLICY FOR THE FOLIAGE GREEN T-SHIRT. DISSEMINATE THIS MESSAGE TO THE LOWEST ECHELON LEVEL.
3. THE FOLIAGE GREEN T-SHIRT IS A STANDARD 100 PERCENT COTTON GREEN T-SHIRT AND IS AUTHORIZED FOR WEAR BY THOSE SOLDIERS IN JOBS THAT HAVE AN ASSOCIATED FLAME RISK OR HAZARD. THOSE SOLDIERS AUTHORIZED WEAR ARE OUTLINED IN CTA 50-900, TABLE 4. THE FOLIAGE GREEN T-SHIRT IS REQUIRED TO SUPPORT THOSE INDIVIDUALS IN ARMOR AND AVIATION FIELDS THAT CANNOT WEAR THE SAND MOISTURE-WICKING T-SHIRT, TO INCLUDE FUEL HANDLERS AND OTHERS WHO HANDLE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS. THIS IMMEDIATELY ALLOWS LEADERS AT ALL LEVELS THE ABILITY TO VISUALLY ENSURE THEIR SOLDIERS ARE WEARING THE CORRECT GARMENT DURING REQUIRED TIMES.
4. THIS WEAR POLICY WILL NOT PREVENT SOLDIERS FROM WEARING THE SAND MOISTURE WICKING T-SHIRT WITH THE ARMY COMBAT UNIFORM (ACU), BUT IT WILL ALLOW THOSE SOLDIERS WHO HAVE AN ASSOCIATED FLAME RISK IN THEIR JOB TO HAVE ALTERNATIVE WEAR WHEN APPROPRIATE.
5. THE FOLIAGE GREEN T-SHIRT IS ONLY AUTHORIZED FOR WEAR BY PERSONNEL PERFORMING MISSIONS IN PARAGRAPH 3 ABOVE.

SUBJECT: CHANGE TO THE ARMY COMBAT UNIFORM (ACU), BATTLE DRESS UNIFORM (BDU), AND DESERT BATTLE DRESS UNIFORM (DBDU) WEAR POLICY

A. AR 670-1, 3 FEB 05, WEAR AND APPEARANCE OF ARMY UNIFORMS AND INSIGNIA.

1. THIS MESSAGE SERVES AS IMPLEMENTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR CHANGES TO THE ACU ENSEMBLE WEAR POLICY AS CONTAINED IN MESSAGE DTG 202200Z APR 05 SAB, BDU, AND THE DBDU WEAR POLICY AS CONTAINED IN AR 670-1, PARAGRAPHS 3-3A, AND 5-3A RESPECTIVELY. THIS POLICY ALLOWS COMMANDERS AND LEADERS AT ALL LEVELS TO MAKE COMMAND DECISIONS TO ALLOW SOLDIERS TO WEAR UTILITY UNIFORMS DURING COMMERCIAL TRAVEL, BASED ON THE MISSION AND THREAT.

2. WE ARE A NATION AT WAR, AND THE UNITED STATES ARMY IS THE MOST TRUSTED ORGANIZATION TO THE AMERICAN PUBLIC. TO KEEP THE DEDICATED EFFORTS OF OUR SOLDIERS VISIBLE TO THE AMERICAN PUBLIC, THE ACU, BDU, AND DBDU ARE AUTHORIZED FOR WEAR DURING COMMERCIAL TRAVEL BOTH CONUS AND OCONUS. IN OCONUS AREAS, COMMANDERS WILL LIMIT TRAVEL IN UNIFORM TO MILITARY AIRLIFT COMMAND (MAC) FLIGHTS OR AMERICAN FLAGGED CARRIERS. COMMANDERS AND LEADERS WILL ENSURE SOLDIERS PRESENT A PROFESSIONAL APPEARANCE AND REFLECT POSITIVELY ON THE ARMY AT ALL TIMES. THE REST AND RECUPERATION PROGRAM HAS BEEN A TREMENDOUS SUCCESS AND THE POLICY REGARDING WEAR OF THE ACU AND DBDU DURING THIS PROGRAM REMAINS IN EFFECT.

3. ACU ENSEMBLE ALARACT MESSAGE DTG 202200Z APR 05 PARAGRAPH 5A IS CHANGED TO READ: THE NEW ACU IS A COMBAT UNIFORM DESIGNED TO BE WORN UNDER BODY ARMOR. THE UNIFORM IS PRESCRIBED FOR YEAR-ROUND WEAR FOR ALL SOLDIERS, UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY THE COMMANDER. SOLDIERS MAY WEAR THE ACU OFF POST UNLESS PROHIBITED BY THE COMMANDER. SOLDIERS MAY WEAR THE ACUs FOR COMMERCIAL TRAVEL, UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY THE COMMANDER. THE WEAR POLICY REMAINS IN EFFECT FOR SOLDIERS PARTICIPATING IN THE REST AND RECUPERATION PROGRAM. PERSONNEL WILL NOT WEAR THE ACU IN OFF-POST ESTABLISHMENTS THAT PRIMARILY SELL ALCOHOL. IF THE OFF-POST ESTABLISHMENT SELLS ALCOHOL AND FOOD, SOLDIERS MAY NOT WEAR THE ACU IF THEIR ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTABLISHMENT CENTER ON DRINKING ALCOHOL. THE ACU IS NOT NORMALLY CONSIDERED APPROPRIATE FOR SOCIAL OR OFFICIAL FUNCTIONS OFF THE INSTALLATION, SUCH AS MEMORIAL SERVICES, FUNERALS, WEDDINGS, INAUGURALS, PATRIOTIC CEREMONIES, ETC. THE ACU IS A COMBAT UNIFORM AND IS NOT INTENDED FOR WEAR AS AN ALL-PURPOSE UNIFORM WHEN OTHER UNIFORMS (CLASS A OR B, DRESS, AND MESS UNIFORM) ARE MORE APPROPRIATE. THE COMMANDER MAY PRESCRIBE

ORGANIZATIONAL AND INDIVIDUAL EQUIPMENT ITEMS IAW CTA 50-900 WHEN THE ACU IS PRESCRIBED FOR PARADES, REVIEWS AND CEREMONIES. THE COMMANDER MAY AUTHORIZE THE WEAR OF SUBDUED PIN ON COMBAT, SPECIAL SKILL, AND IDENTIFICATION BADGES IN GARRISON. COMBAT AND SPECIAL SKILL BADGES WILL NOT BE SEWN OR ATTACHED USING HOOK AND LOOP PADS ON THE ACU. SEWING OF THE RANK INSIGNIA ON THE ACU PATROL CAP, ACU SUN HAT, AND KEVLAR CAMOUFLAGE COVER IS AUTHORIZED. THE ACU WILL BE LOOSE FITTING AND COMFORTABLE; ALTERATIONS TO MAKE THEM FIT TIGHTLY ARE NOT AUTHORIZED. THE ONLY ALTERATIONS AUTHORIZED ARE THOSE LISTED IN AR 700-84. ITEMS SHOULD BE FITTED LOOSELY ENOUGH TO ALLOW FOR SOME SHRINKAGE WITHOUT RENDERING THE GARMENT UNUSABLE.

4. AR 670-1 PARAGRAPH 3-3A IS CHANGED TO READ: SOLDIERS MAY WEAR BDUs ON DUTY WHEN PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMANDER. SOLDIERS MAY WEAR BDUs OFF POST UNLESS PROHIBITED BY THE COMMANDER. THEY MAY WEAR BDUs FOR COMMERCIAL TRAVEL, UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY THE COMMANDER. PERSONNEL MAY NOT WEAR BDUs IN ESTABLISHMENTS THAT PRIMARILY SELL ALCOHOL. IF THE ESTABLISHMENT SELLS ALCOHOL AND FOOD, SOLDIERS MAY NOT WEAR BDUs IF THEIR ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTABLISHMENT CENTER ON DRINKING ALCOHOL ONLY.

5. AR 670-1 PARAGRAPH 5-3A IS CHANGED TO READ: PERSONNEL WEAR THE DBDU ON DUTY WHEN PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMANDER. SOLDIERS MAY WEAR THE DBDU OFF POST, UNLESS PROHIBITED BY THE COMMANDER. THEY MAY WEAR THE DBDUs FOR COMMERCIAL TRAVEL, UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY THE COMMANDER. PERSONNEL MAY NOT WEAR DBDUs IN ESTABLISHMENTS THAT PRIMARILY SELL ALCOHOL. IF THE ESTABLISHMENT SELLS ALCOHOL AND FOOD, SOLDIERS MAY NOT WEAR DBDUs IF THEIR ACTIVITIES IN THE ESTABLISHMENT CENTER ON DRINKING ALCOHOL ONLY.

SUBJECT: AR 670-1, 3 FEB 05, WEAR AND APPEARANCE OF ARMY UNIFORMS AND INSIGNIA

1. THIS MESSAGE SERVES AS IMPLEMENTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR CHANGES TO THE WEAR POLICY OUTLINED IN AR 670-1 AND MESSAGES OUTLINING THE WEAR POLICY FOR THE ARMY COMBAT UNIFORM (ACU).

2. EFFECTIVE 1 NOVEMBER 2006 THE ARMY WHITE UNIFORM IS NO LONGER AUTHORIZED FOR WEAR.

3. AR 670-1, PARAGRAPH 1-14A IS CHANGED TO READ: SOLDIERS MAY WEAR A WRISTWATCH, A WRIST IDENTIFICATION BRACELET, AND A TOTAL OF TWO RINGS (A WEDDING SET IS CONSIDERED ONE RING) WITH ARMY UNIFORMS, UNLESS PROHIBITED BY THE COMMANDER FOR SAFETY OR HEALTH REASONS. ANY JEWELRY SOLDIERS WEAR MUST BE CONSERVATIVE AND IN GOOD TASTE. IDENTIFICATION BRACELETS ARE LIMITED TO MEDICAL ALERT BRACELETS, MIA/POW IDENTIFICATION BRACELETS, AND REMEMBRANCE BRACELETS. SOLDIERS MAY WEAR ONLY ONE ITEM ON EACH WRIST.

4. AR 670-1, PARAGRAPH 1-14B IS CHANGED TO READ: JEWELRY OUTLINED IN AR 670-1, PARAGRAPH 1-14A AND PENS/PENCILS WORN IN THE PEN/PENCIL SLOTS ON THE ACU COAT CAN BE EXPOSED. NOTE: THERE ARE NO STIPULATIONS ON THE COLORS OR PENS/PENCILS WORN IN THE SLOTS OF THE ACU COAT. OTHER AUTHORIZED EXCEPTIONS ARE RELIGIOUS ITEMS DESCRIBED IN AR 670-1, PARAGRAPH 1-7B, A CONSERVATIVE TIE TACK OR TIE CLASP THAT MALE SOLDIERS MAY WEAR WITH THE BLACK FOUR-IN-HAND NECKTIE; AND A PEN OR PENCIL THAT MAY APPEAR EXPOSED ON THE HOSPITAL DUTY, FOOD SERVICE, COMBAT VEHICLE CREWMAN UNIFORM, OR FLIGHT UNIFORMS.

5. AR 670-1, PARAGRAPH 1-9A(2)(B) IS CHANGED TO PROHIBIT WEAR OF WIRELESS BLUETOOTH DEVICES WHILE WEARING ARMY UNIFORMS.

6. AS AN EXCEPTION TO CURRENT POLICY OUTLINED IN AR 670-1, PARAGRAPH 1-15, SUNGLASSES THAT HAVE BEEN ISSUED BY THE ARMY WITH INITIALS, DESIGNS, OR OTHER ADORNMENT ARE AUTHORIZED FOR WEAR. THE REMAINING WEAR POLICY OUTLINED IN AR 670-1, PARAGRAPH 1-15 STILL APPLY.

7. AR 670-1, PARAGRAPH 1-10E(2) IS CHANGED TO AUTHORIZE WEAR OF THE BLACK, ACU UNIVERSAL PATTERN, AND FOLIAGE GREEN GYM BAGS, CIVILIAN RUCKSACKS, OR OTHER SIMILAR CIVILIAN BAGS WHILE IN UNIFORM. THE REMAINING WEAR POLICIES OUTLINED IN AR 670-1, PARAGRAPH 1-10E(2) STILL APPLY.

8. NON-SUBDUED SSI (S) ARE NOT AUTHORIZED TO BE WORN ON UTILITY UNIFORMS AS A SSI OR SSI-FWTS. LEADERS WILL ENSURE SOLDIERS COMPLY IMMEDIATELY. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO POLICY CURRENTLY APPROVED AUTHORIZING WEAR OF ANY NON-SUBDUED SSI ON UTILITY UNIFORMS.

9. COMBAT, SPECIAL SKILL, AND IDENTIFICATION BADGES ARE NOT AUTHORIZED TO BE WORN ON THE ACU IN FIELD OR WITHIN DEPLOYED ENVIRONMENTS.

10. SUBDUED PIN ON OR SEWN ON RANK IS WORN ON THE ACU SUN (BOONIE) HAT AND THE ACU PATROL CAP.

11. AR 670-1, PARAGRAPHS 6-2C(4), 6-5E, AND 12-2C(1) IS CHANGED AUTHORIZING WEAR OF THE BLACK LEATHER BOOTS, TAN COMBAT BOOTS, OR OPTIONAL TAN BOOTS SIMILAR TO THE TAN COMBAT BOOTS WITH THE AIRCREW BATTLE DRESS UNIFORM AND THE FLIGHT UNIFORM.

12. THE MILITARY POLICE (MP) AND CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION DIVISION (CID) INSIGNIAS ARE AUTHORIZED TO BE WORN ON THE ACU. THE INSIGNIAS ARE PLACED DIRECTLY ON TOP OF THE HOOK AND LOOP-FACED PAD ALREADY PROVIDED ON THE LEFT SLEEVE OF THE ACU COAT SHOULDER POCKET FLAP. THE INSIGNIAS ARE WORN AS DIRECTED BY THE COMMANDER.

2. THE PURPOSE OF THIS MESSAGE IS TO ANNOUNCE THE WEAR POLICY FOR THE U.S. ARMY LOGO PATCH. DISSEMINATE THIS MESSAGE TO THE LOWEST ECHELON LEVEL.
3. THE U.S. ARMY LOGO PATCH IS APPROVED FOR WEAR ON THE ARMY COMBAT UNIFORM (ACU) FOR THE FOLLOWING UNITS:
 - A. HEADQUARTERS, DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY (ARSTAF ONLY)
 - B. UNITED STATES ARMY ACCESSIONS COMMAND
 - C. UNITED STATES ARMY ACCESSIONS SUPPORT BRIGADE
 - D. INITIAL ENTRY TRAINING SOLDIERS (IET) (ALL)
 - E. ONE STATION UNIT TRAINING SOLDIERS (OSUT) (ALL)
4. THE FOLLOWING PARAGRAPHS (1-12 AND 28-16), RESPECTIVELY IN AR 670-1 HAVE BEEN CHANGED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
 - A. 1-12B (1) ADDED: WHEN APPROVED FOR WEAR ON A UNIFORM UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH 28-16 BELOW, THE U.S. ARMY LOGO IS NOT CONSIDERED A DISTINCTIVE UNIFORM ITEM.
 - B. 28-16D ADDED: THE U. S. ARMY LOGO ("LOGO") IS A REGISTERED TRADEMARK OF THE ARMY, VISUALLY CENTRAL TO THE ARMY'S BRANDING AND TRADEMARKED LICENSING PROGRAM ADMINISTERED ON BEHALF OF THE ARMY BY THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF THE

ARMY (MANPOWER AND RESERVE AFFAIRS (ASA) [M&RA]). THE LOGO MAY BE WORN WHEN AUTHORIZED BY THE CHIEF OF STAFF, ARMY PROVIDED THE SHAPE, COLORS, AND STYLISTIC DESIGN OF ANY SUCH PATCH COMPORT WITH THE DESIGN OF THE LOGO AS PRESCRIBED BY THE ASA (M&RA). WHEN WORN ON A UNIFORM, THE LOGO WILL NOT BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE "®" SYMBOL. THE U.S. ARMY LOGO PATCH IS NOT CONSIDERED A DISTINCTIVE INSIGNIA IN THE SAME MANNER AS THE SHOULDER SLEEVE INSIGNIA. THE U.S. ARMY LOGO PATCH IS AUTHORIZED FOR WEAR BY THE FOLLOWING:

- (1) U.S. ARMY ACCESSIONS COMMAND
- (2) U.S. ARMY ACCESSIONS COMMAND SUPPORT BRIGADE
- (3) OFFICER AND ENLISTED PERSONNEL ASSIGNED TO HQDA (ARSTAF ONLY)
- (4) IET AND OSUT SOLDIERS

C. 28-16E(2) ENLISTED PERSONNEL ATTACHED TO HEADQUARTERS COMPANY, U.S. ARMY, WHO ARE ASSIGNED TO OR PERFORMING DUTY WITH HQDA STAFF AGENCIES AND OFFICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE, WILL WEAR THE U.S. ARMY LOGO CENTERED ON THE LEFT SLEEVE OF THE HOOK AND LOOP PAD ALREADY PROVIDED ON THE ACU IN PLACE OF THEIR SSI. NO SSI IS WORN FOR OFFICER PERSONNEL ASSIGNED AND ARNG TITLE 10 LONG-TOUR PROGRAM OFFICERS ATTACHED TO HQDA ON THE BDU, DBDU, ARMY GREEN UNIFORM, OR BDU FIELD JACKET. OFFICER PERSONNEL ASSIGNED OR ATTACHED TO HQDA (ARSTAF ONLY) WILL WEAR THE U.S. ARMY LOGO CENTERED ON THE LEFT SLEEVE OF THE HOOK AND LOOP PAD ALREADY PROVIDED ON THE ACU. OFFICER PERSONNEL ASSIGNED OR ATTACHED TO HQDA WILL NOT WEAR A SSI ON THE LEFT SLEEVE OF THE BDU, DBDU, ARMY GREEN UNIFORM, OR BDU FIELD JACKET.

E. 28-16E(14) ADDED: UNITED STATES ARMY ACCESSIONS COMMAND AND UNITED STATES ARMY ACCESSIONS SUPPORT BRIGADE ARE AUTHORIZED TO WEAR THE U.S. ARMY LOGO PATCH CENTERED ON THE LEFT SLEEVE OF THE HOOK AND LOOP PAD ALREADY PROVIDED ON THE ACU IN PLACE OF THEIR SSI. SOLDIERS WILL CONTINUE TO WEAR THE SSI APPROVED FOR TRADOC ON THE BDU, DBDU, ARMY GREEN UNIFORM, AND BDU FIELD JACKET.

F. 28-16E(15) ADDED: IET SOLDIERS WILL WEAR THE U.S. ARMY LOGO CENTERED ON THE LEFT SLEEVE OF THE HOOK AND LOOP PAD ALREADY PROVIDED ON THE ACU. THE U.S. ARMY LOGO PATCH WILL BE AWARDED AND WORN BY IET SOLDIERS DURING THE 6TH WEEK OF BCT. IET SOLDIERS ARE NOT AUTHORIZED TO WEAR A SSI OR THE U.S. ARMY LOGO PATCH ON THE ARMY GREEN UNIFORM.

G. 28-16F(2); SUBDUED. ALL PERSONNEL WEAR THE SUBDUED SSI ON THE TEMPERATE, HOT-WEATHER, ENHANCED HOT-WEATHER, AVIATION, AND DESERT BDU; FLIGHT SUIT AND FLIGHT JACKET; COMBAT VEHICLE CREWMAN UNIFORM; AND THE BDU FIELD JACKET. SELECTED PERSONNEL ARE AUTHORIZED TO WEAR THE SUBDUED U.S. ARMY LOGO PATCH IN PLACE OF THEIR SSI ON THE ACU. PERSONNEL WILL NOT WEAR SUBDUED SSI ON HOSPITAL DUTY AND FOOD SERVICE UNIFORMS. POSITIONING OF THE INSIGNIA IS IDENTICAL TO THE NON-SUBDUED INSIGNIA, COVERED IN (28-16F(1)) FOR ALL UNIFORMS EXCEPT THE ACU. THE SUBDUED SSI OR SUBDUED U.S. ARMY LOGO PATCH WILL BE CENTERED ON THE LEFT HOOK AND LOOP PAD ALREADY PROVIDED ON THE ACU.
