- ❖ eMS = Environmental Management System
 - ◆ The Management System we use to implement the Adjutant General's (TAG's) Environmental Management policy.
 - ◆ The basic content of the Policy Letter:
 - i. Commitment to continual improvement.
 - ii. Commitment to Prevention Pollution.
 - iii. Commitment to comply with all environmental laws, regulations, and other requirements (SOP's etc.) to which we subscribe.
- ❖ Most Importantly: RECYCLE / REUSE
 - ◆ **Know the Environmental Impacts of Your Job!**

SPILL RESPONSE

For Small / Incidental Spill Response

1. Stop flow only if absolutely safe to do so.
2. Prevent spill from entering surface water or drainage systems.
3. Absorb or accumulate the spill using dry sweep. Absorbent socks, pads, or soil.
4. A spill incident report should be filed with the Environmental office within 72 Hours of a spill.

Only qualified and trained personnel should engage in spill response and clean-up operations. Contact your unit compliance officer immediately after a spill. Dispose of all clean-up material IAW local regulations.
