**HOW TO APPLY:**

**INTERESTED APPLICANTS MUST FORWARD THIS CHECKLIST WITH THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTATION IN ORDER, NO BINDERS OR STAPLES PLEASE!**

1. Initial Resume
2. Initial Photograph: Within One Year
  - Official Military Photo in Army Service Uniform. Photo in Army Combat Uniform accepted if Service member does not have dress uniform. If not available submit memo explaining why you do not have a dress uniform photo (if applicable).
3. Initial Last five DA Form 67-9 (OER). Must show previous successful leadership experience. Performance counseling acceptable if Soldier has no NCOERs. Submit a memo to the President of the Board, explaining reason(s) for any missing or not requiring of NOCERs.
4. Initial Validated copy of O RB
5. Initial Copy of current DA Form 705 (Army Physical Fitness Test Scorecard) with minimum of the last two scores.
  - a. **Must have successfully completed and passed most recent APFT within 6 months.** Ensure DA Form 705 states, "FOR RECORD GO".
  - b. **Must include any Medical Documents AS APPLICABLE** (Permanent Profiles, Retention Physical).
6. Initial DA Form 1058-R (Application for Active Duty for Training, Active Duty for Special Work, Temporary Tour of Active Duty, and Annual Training for Soldiers of the Army National Guard and U.S. Army Reserve), Dated JUL 2010
7. Initial NGB Form 1058-1R, (Checklist for Determining the Approval Authority for Active Duty AD or Full-Time National Guard Duty FTNGD Special work long and short tours other than Active Guard Reserve), Dated JUL 02
8. Initial Retirement Points History Statement (RPAS) dated within 30 days.
9. Initial MEDPROS Printout (**MUST HAVE A PHA WITHIN 12 MONTHS OF PROPOSED START DATE.**)
10. Initial Current Security Clearance Memo from security manager (**MUST HAVE SECRET.**)
11. Initial Current DA 5500/5501 (If applicable)
12. Initial Copy of documentation showing military education completed for: MOS, NCOES and OES (Office Educations System) (i.e. 1059's).

**PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

**Major duties:** The Nevada National Guard JFHQ is looking an individual to serve as the Operations Officer (OPSO/XO) for the Vigilant Guard 17 exercise. Funding of Orders is expected for 15 months upon hire. Additional **orders are contingent upon availability of FY 16 funding.** Applicants should present a favorable military image and will be required to uphold the highest standards of conduct and military personal appearance while on ADOS tour. Outside employment, associations and off-duty conduct/activities must be consistent with federal directives on ethics and with state and federal conflict of interest policies. Frequent travel may be required

**SUPERVISORY CONTROLS:**

A. Works under the general supervision of the Administration Officer, Operations NCO, Battalion Training Officer, unit commander and readiness NCO. Receives technical guidance from supervisory personnel at higher headquarters. Accomplishes daily requirements independently in accordance with established policies and procedures. Performance is evaluated on accomplishment of established objectives.

**Must be able to attend Project Officers Course in West Virginia 10-14 August 2015**

**MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

Individuals who have been involuntarily separated from the AGR program or Full Time National Guard Duty are not eligible to reenter the program. Must meet medical standards prescribed by AR 40-501 chapter 3. You will be required to complete a physical exam if you do not have a current one within the last two years. Must not be under a current suspension of favorable personnel actions. Applicants who voluntarily separate from the AGR program for one or more days are not eligible to reenter the program for one year from date of separation without an NGB approved waiver. Applicants must not be entitled to receive Federal military retired or retainer pay or Federal civil service annuities and not be eligible for immediate Federal civil service annuities. Applicants who are over grade may apply, but must indicate in writing a willingness to be administratively reduced in grade when assigned to the position. Members must remain in the position in which initially assigned for a minimum of 18 months. The initial tour length is three years. Failure to become MOSQ within the specified period is grounds for mandatory involuntary separation from the AGR program. Applicants must meet the physical demands rating and qualifications for award of MOS in accordance with AR 611-21 and NGR 600-200. Must meet Army Physical Fitness standards and height and weight standards as prescribed by AR 350-1 and AR 600-9. Must have sufficient time remaining (ETS) (MRD) to permit completion of tour of duty. Subsequent tour(s) will be based on authorized force structure in effect. PCS funds have been authorized if in the best interest of the government.
