MEMORANDUM FOR: ALL Units & Activities SUBJECT: Alcohol Consumption and Gambling

1. It is the policy of the Commander Army Guard that Nevada Army National Guard soldiers will not consume alcoholic beverages or engage in gambling while on duty and/or in uniform.
2. Alcoholic beverages may be consumed after duty hours, in uniform only at authorized locations on military installations, i.e. SANGA, enlisted/officers clubs, at official military functions such as the military ball, or with written permission from the State Command Sergeant Major (SCSM), or myself.
3. Commanders requesting permission for the consumption of alcohol at unit functions will make their request in writing and include an events safety/supervisory plan to include at a minimum:
 - a. Location
 - b. Vehicle key control system
 - c. Designated Drivers
 - d. Limits on consumption
4. In these times of shrinking budgets and public scrutiny we must project our image of a well-trained, disciplined professional military organization. Public consumption of alcoholic beverages or engaging in gambling while in uniform brings discredit upon the uniform, the individual, and the organization.
